### 1.3 Structure & Clarity

Your article should follow a clear and organized structure:

- Engaging introduction
- Logical progression of ideas
- Headings and subheadings
- Bullet points where helpful
- Strong conclusion or takeaway

## 1.4 Accuracy & Supporting Evidence

- Use verified information, reliable sources, and credible data.
- Provide citations for research, statistics, quotes, or referenced materials.
- Avoid unverified claims or speculation without context.

## 1.5 Tone & Style

Your tone may be:

- **Technical**
- **Analytical**
- **Conversational**
- **Thought-leadership oriented**

Regardless of style, the content must always be:

- Accurate
  - Insightful
  - Clear and readable
  - Targeted toward an audience familiar with AI and technology

## 2. Formatting Guidelines

### 2.1 File Format

Submit your article in any of the following formats:

- **Google Doc** (preferred)
- **Microsoft Word (.docx)**
- **Markdown (.md)**

### 2.2 Required Elements

Every article must include:

- **Title**
- **Short Summary (2–4 sentences)**

- **Author Name**
- **Author Bio (2–3 lines)**
- **Website or Social Link (LinkedIn preferred)**

### **2.3 Visual & Supporting Materials (Optional)**

You may attach:

- Images, charts, or diagrams
    - Must be copyright-free or owned by you
    - Include source or attribution if required
  - Research links or datasets
  - Product or company details (if discussing a tool)
    - Must be educational, not purely promotional
